## World Amateur Team Championships

#### 2022 WATC France

➢ It was reported that preparations for the 2022 WATC France are continuing to go well and that fifty-seven entries had been received for the Espirito Santo Trophy, whilst the Eisenhower Trophy is fully subscribed with seventy-two entries.

#### 2025 WATC Bid Process

The 2025 WATC Bid Evaluation Panel has reviewed the Singapore Golf Association and Royal Moroccan Golf Federation bids according to the evaluation process and highly marked both candidates' bids and believe both could deliver a WATC of excellent quality.
